



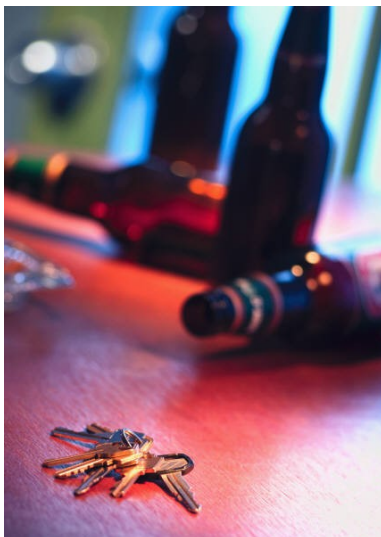
THE MSU POLICE WANT YOU TO BE IN THE KNOW...

What's important to know about the Drunk/Drugged Driving Laws in Michigan:

- It's a crime for a Driver to have a BAC of .08 or greater.
- The Super Drunk Law has a BAC of .17 or greater.
- It's a crime for Drivers to have any trace of a scheduled 1 narcotic (marijuana, cocaine) in their system, even if they show no signs of impairment.
- Over 50,000 Drivers are arrested annually in Michigan for impaired driving.
- 299 alcohol related fatalities occurred in Michigan in 2009.
- 10,839 alcohol related fatalities occurred in the United States in 2009.
- All of the above.
